Dear Ms. Monroe:

I respectfully request to intervene in the SEC's proceeding under Docket No. 2015-06 relating to the proposed Northern Pass transmission line. Per the SEC's regulations, I am sending this request to you, with copies to the SEC's distribution list for this proceeding as noted in the "cc" below.

My reasons to seek intervenor status are as follows:

1. My wife and I own property on Paine Rd., a lightly traveled secondary town road that ends at its intersection with NH Rt. 116. In order for us to go anywhere beyond Paine Rd., we must travel on Rt. 116 - we have no alternative route to anywhere. For this reason, we feel a need to closely monitor the massive road disruption that will occur in the process of burying the HVDC power transmission lines under the center of Rt. 116 in Easton, in order to be assured we will still be able to get to stores and gas stations for our needs.
2. I'm a retired electrical engineer with an advanced degree in electrical engineering. As such, I believe I have technical knowledge that may be useful in evaluating the potential adverse health effects caused by electromagnetic radiation on individuals living close to the roads under which the HVDC will be buried.
3. As a former two-term selectman in the Town of Easton, I've had a long term interest in the town and the welfare of its residents.
4. I've had a long-standing active interest in monitoring the Northern Pass Transmission Project, and how it might adversely impact the Town of Easton and its residents. I currently am a documented intervenor in the US DOE Northern Pass Transmission Application for Presidential Permit. (See Certificate of Service relative to this Application, copy attached.)

For the reasons stated above, I respectfully request that the SEC issue an order granting this petition for me to intervene in this matter.
