The Town of Franconia owns land situated on Route 116 and Route 18, land which is bounded by two rivers. This is the proposed route on which the Northern Pass Transmission Line is to be situated. The application submitted, October 19, 2015, is incomplete because the applicant has not shown that it has secured the legal and necessary land and property rights on which to construct the proposed underground high voltage direct current ("UGHVDC") transmission line in Franconia. As such, we believe the NH Site Evaluation Committee has no authority to grant such land and property rights.

Additionally, the land on which the Northern Pass Transmission Line is to be situated includes land abutting and/or underneath all of the following: Route 118 in Franconia and Route 116 in Franconia.

Furthermore, the applicant has failed to give proper notice to all abutters. Therefore, it is our position that the aforesaid application is administratively incomplete.
