The only reasons that Eversource has ever given for its refusal to bury the NP project is that it is too expensive or technically impractical. They have never presented the public with research and numbers to validate their claims. Their stated objections to undergrounding the project are based on no evidence at all. Their competitors in Vermont and Maine plan fully buried projects of similar distances and still find them to be financially viable. If Eversource can't handle the technical processes. or they can't financially justify the effort, then they are obviously not qualified to do the job.

There are now examples of cost effective, buried, long line HVDC projects world wide so, any claims made by Eversource that the technology or construction techniques are immature are patently untrue. In fact, *Trans Energie*, a construction subsidiary of Hydro Quebec, takes pride in having installed the worlds longest buried HVDC project in Australia. Further, they have testified before FERC that project burial is cost competitive with overhead installations and has lower maintenance costs. Long term it saves money because it does not suffer storm damage. I have attached excerpts of that testimony to validate these statements.

No speculative, for profit, corporate project should ever take precedence over the welfare of the public. We must not damage the health and welfare of citizens, town tax bases, property values, local economies or the aesthetics of our state for a corporate bottom line. Bury it or forget it.
