Re: The Weeks Lancaster Trust's Recommendation for Procedural Schedule, Docket No. 2015-06

On behalf of the Weeks Lancaster Trust, as well as all parties involved in SEC Docket 2015-06, I would like to urge the SEC to adopt the Procedural Schedule proposed by the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests. We are aware that this is an historic and complex undertaking. All the elements of this Procedure: the number of parties, the many issues, the volume of data to be assessed, and the large distances, indicate that this process warrants Time and Careful Analysis. In order to serve the citizens and property owners in the state with due respect, we do not believe that a twelve-month schedule is reasonable or advisable. The stakes for everyone in the State are very high and a precipitous decision may result in a very damaging result to all concerned.

The Weeks Lancaster Trust strongly supports adding 12 months to the SEC schedule. December 17, 2017 would be a much more reasonable finish date for a procedure of this magnitude.
