

**APPLICATION OF CHARIOT SOLAR, LLC FOR A CERTIFICATE OF
SITE AND FACILITY FOR THE CHARIOT SOLAR PROJECT IN
HINSDALE, NEW HAMPSHIRE**

Applicant's Request to Waive Certain Application Filing Requirements

NOW COMES Chariot Solar, LLC (“Chariot”), by and through their attorneys, and submits this request pursuant to Admin. Rule Site 302.05 to waive the requirement that an applicant submit an original and 15 copies of the Application and accompanying materials to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee (“Committee”) and that it submit oversized documents by folding them and putting them in protective tubes. In support of this request, Chariot states the following:

1. Chariot will soon file an Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility to construct a 50MW solar generating facility in Hinsdale, New Hampshire (“the Application”). Chariot held a public information session in Hinsdale on October 18, 2021 as required by law and notified the Committee of this public information session. As a result of that notification the Committee opened the above-captioned docket.

2. Site 301.01(a) requires that an applicant file an original and 15 copies of the Application with the Committee, as well as an electronic version of the Application in PDF format “unless otherwise directed by the chairperson or the administrator...” Site 301.02(2) requires that oversized documents be folded to an 8 1/2 x 11 inch sheet size and provided in protective tubes.

3. Site 302.05 gives the Committee the authority to waive any provisions of the rules, except where precluded by statute, upon the request of an interested party, provided that the Committee finds that the waiver services the public interest, and that it will not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Committee. In determining the public interest, the Committee shall waive the rule if compliance would be onerous or inapplicable or the purpose of the rule would be satisfied by an alternative method. The Committee has granted such waivers in the past. *See*, for example, Order on Procedural Waiver Request, April 6, 2016 in SEC Docket No. 2015-04 (“Order on Waiver Request”); *see also*, Order on Procedural Waiver Request, September 5, 2019 in SEC Docket No. 2019-02.

4. Chariot anticipates that the Application will be hundreds of pages long, that many documents will be oversized, and that meeting these requirements would require a number of three ring binders. When this is multiplied by 15 copies and by the number of pages involved, as well as the number of documents that will have to be folded and put into protective tubes, the effort will be substantial and will require a significant amount of time and resources.

5. In order to conserve resources and to make it more convenient for the agencies involved, as well as Public Counsel, the Town of Hinsdale (the “Town”), and any intervenors, Chariot respectfully requests that the Committee waive the requirement that it generate complete paper copies for each recipient. Chariot will still provide an original of the Application materials to the Committee, including the pre-filed testimony, all related appendices and reports in 8 ½ x 11 inch binders, and the Project maps, visual impact assessment report and related photo simulations unfolded in an 11 x 17 inch


binder, 6 paper copies of the Application and pre-filed testimony, and 10 electronic copies of the Application and all associated attachments in PDF format on USB thumbdrives or other electronic media. *See* Order on Waiver Request, pp. 3-4. Chariot will also coordinate with Public Counsel and the Town and provide them with copies that will meet their preferences, and provide such other copies as directed by the Committee.

6. Chariot submits that granting this request will serve the public interest, and that it will not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Committee. The alternative method described above, which was approved by the Committee in SEC Docket No. 2015-04 and SEC Docket 2019-02, will serve the public interest by conserving resources but still satisfying the purpose of the rule.

WHEREFORE, Chariot respectfully requests that the Committee:

- A. Grant a waiver pursuant to Site 302.05 as described above; and
- B. Grant such other relief as the Committee deems appropriate.
