I am writing to you in my capacity as counsel for the New Hampshire Energy Facility Site Evaluation Committee. On or about July 15, 2008, Granite Reliable Power, LLC, filed an Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility for the construction and operation of thirty-three (33) wind turbines (and associated facilities and roads) with a total nameplate generation capacity of ninety-nine (99) megawatts (MW) to be known as the Granite Reliable Windpark. The proposed project is located in central Coos County within the Town of Dummer and the unincorporated places known as Dixville, Erving's Location, Millsfield and Odell. This matter has been docketed as Site Evaluation Committee No. 2008-004.

Pursuant to R.S.A. 162-H:16, IV(b), the Site Evaluation Committee, as part of its review, must consider whether the site and facility will "unduly interfere with the orderly development of the region with due consideration having been given to the views of municipal and regional planning commissions and municipal governing bodies". The purpose of this letter is to provide you with notice of the filing of the Application. 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If the Chairman of the Site Evaluation Committee, Thomas Burack, determines that the Application contains sufficient information to carry out the purposes of R.S.A.162-H, this matter will be scheduled for public information hearings and further proceedings consistent with the time frames set forth for Renewable Energy Facilities in R.S.A. 162-H;6-a. You will receive notice of all such proceedings. If the unincorporated place of Dixville wishes to intervene as a party in this docket, it will be necessary for you to file a motion to intervene, consistent with R.S.A. 541-A:32 and N.H. CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS, Site 202.11.

Please consider this letter as notice pursuant to R.S.A. 541-A:39. As an affected municipality, you have the right to a reasonable opportunity to submit data, views, or comments with respect to the Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility. If you wish to provide such information it may be mailed to the office of the Chairman of the Site Evaluation Committee:
