I am attempting to review a document entitled Revised Petitioner Exhibit 45(a) that was supplied to the committee on March 31. I am finding that understanding the information provided in this exhibit is nearly impossible because it heavily references information in the System Impact Study Report (SIS), Release 6, which has not been made available for public review. Your website lists the SIS (www.nhsec.nh.gov/2008-04/documents/app_appendix_8.pdf) as not available.

I hope the committee will understand that the information provided in this exhibit and the SIS is extremely important to Coos County. These numbers will impact future regional growth patterns and could impact citizens near the transmission loop.

I would like to request the committee insure that the final SIS is completed and given ample time for public review before a final decision is made on this project.

I also think the information provided in this exhibit is void of two critical pieces of information. First, the projected energy loss on each leg of the loop (in KVA) and second, the current and projected electromagnetic (EMF) and electrostatic radiation levels within the transmission line easement after the various modifications are applied. If this information is not available in the SIS, I would request the committee request that specific information and post it for public review.
