



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

The City of Berlin, NH, requests written proposals  
from qualified firms or individuals interested in being  
considered for hire by the City as a Relocation  
Specialist to manage a \$4,500,000 Neighborhood  
Stabilization Program (NSP) Project. The project  
involves the rehabilitation of approximately 35 units  
of housing, demolition of approximately 25 buildings  
and the issuance of 50 new Section 8 vouchers. In  
certain targeted areas of Berlin, responsibilities  
include: Adherence to the requirements set forth  
under the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real  
Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 as amended;  
coordination with the City and its partner New  
England Family Housing, reporting, record keeping,  
financial accounting, monitoring for adherence to  
federal regulations, meetings, project coordination,  
and supervision.

The amount of work will be dependent on the  
buildings affected by the program and the number of  
occurrences encountered.  
This project is funded through a Neighborhood
