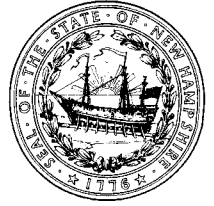

 - a) *Application must be signed by the town*
 - b) *Design drawings – requirements in Env-Wq 703.03, 703.04 and 703.05*
 - c) *Technical specifications – requirements in Env-Wq 703.02*
 - d) *A review fee - \$0.10/gallon for first 10,000 gallons and \$0.05 for each gallon over 10,000*
