Pursuant to the above-referenced Order, Burgess BioPower, LLC (successor to Laidlaw Berlin BioPower, LLC) hereby submits its 2016 Sustainability Report.

Burgess BioPower purchased approximately 747,907 tons of biomass in 2016:

- Volume of biomass supplied from certified timberlands/operations: 67,369 tons
- Volume of biomass supplied from timber sales managed by a licensed forester: 101,792 tons
- Volume of biomass supplied by certified professional loggers: 232,946 tons
- Volume of biomass supplied mill residue and non-forestry sources: 85,042 tons
- Number of loggers enrolled in certification programs by Burgess BioPower support: 0
