Dear Mr. Drew,

I am writing on behalf of a fairly large group of citizens in Rumney, NH. I am also the chair of the Rumney Democratic Caucus. By way of reference, I refer you to Executive Councilor Ray Burton; Martha Richards, Grafton County Commissioner, Carol Friedrich, state representative, district 6; and Deb Reynolds, NH state senator from Plymouth how can comment on my community role.

People in Rumney are concerned about two parts of the Groton Wind Project. One is the specific location of the proposed wind turbines. We have been to a map in the power point presentation from Iberdrola listed on the town of Groton's web site, but it only seems to show a map of Groton and abutting communities [pg.17]. If you could direct me to a specific NHSEC webpage or alternate link that shows the specific locations of the proposed turbines that would be most helpful and appreciated.

Secondly, many people are concerned about the lack of public awareness of this project. Communication seems as if it could have been and could be better. There will be a public meeting in Rumney Thursday, April 22 @ 6:00pm at the Rumney Russell School. For your information, this will be the first time Rumney residents will have an opportunity to have an interactive dialogue with Ed Cherian of Iberdrola.

There are many in Rumney who favor projects such as this as well as those who are opposed. They have their reasons as well. Your assistance in helping me to share appropriate information with everyone on this project would be most appreciated.
