Dear Mr Freitas,

In follow-up from our telephone conversation earlier today I am formally inviting representatives from Plymouth's Selectman's Office and any other interested Plymonites to attend this Thursday, April 22 @ 6PM in Rumney's Russell Elementary School informative meeting regarding the Groton Wind Site Project, 12 turbines of which are planned for the Tenney Mt Ridge in Plymouth overlooking Rt 25 and its inhabitants. Diverse controversy has percolated the past few weeks regarding possible health hazards (Turbine Wind Syndrome per N. Peirpont, MD, PhD, et al), environmental impact (turbine precipitated forest fires, risk for turbine blades or ice-blocks to disconnect and risk impacting moving traffic on Route 25), and a number of other issues. Since Rumney and Plymouth run the risk of potential harmful negligence from this project perhaps it would be of interest for you folks to take advantage of this meeting as abutting members of the greater community.
