In addition to being supportive of the effort of Iberdrola to provide an renewable source of power to the state of New Hampshire I would like to know that the SEC will investigate the following two areas of concern fully before the project is allowed to go forward.

- 1. Does Iberdrola in fact have a plan which will provide adequate funds for FULL removal of the 24 proposed turbines as needed when they break partially or totally or when the land lease has expired?
- 2. Iberdrola tells us that there are not problems from the sound of the turbines yet there are numerous studies and first-hand reports by individuals that disagree with this stand.
 - a. The Groton site puts turbines less than a mile from several residences and sound is amplified by the combination of mountains and valleys.
 - b. Five campgrounds with tent sites will be seriously impacted if the sound can be heard from those sites even if it is just steady and not particularly loud
