I am writing in response to the question raised at the pre-hearing conference held on October 2, 2013 regarding question (1).

Did the Department of Environmental Services have the authority to modify the certificate regarding the placement of the O & M building and the turbines?

My answer is no.

Action was disregarded by Iberdrola Renewables Inc. and the Department of Environmental Services by not copying the NH Site Evaluation Committee when the proposed amendment was submitted to amend the original DES Permit originally approved on October 8, 2010.

The amended DES Permit dated December 5, 2011 states: (The new location of the O & M Building is considered a minor plan revision).

It is clear with the new location of the O & M Building it is not considered a "minor plan revision".

The new location of the O & M Building created new abutters.

According to RSA 162-H:6-a 7 & 10 we have been denied our right to be heard, and due to this disregard property values in our neighborhood will never be able to be sold for fair market value.
