**AGENDA FOR TECHNICAL SESSION
ON APRIL 1, 2014**

A Technical Session will be held in this docket on April 1, 2014. The Technical Session shall begin at 10:00 A.M. The Technical Session shall be held in Hearing Room A at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord N.H., 03301.

This Technical Session will be an informal opportunity for the parties to ask questions of the witness proffered by the Fire Marshal: Investigator Ronald Anstey who has filed testimony in this matter. The following rules and procedures shall apply:

1. Schedule of Witnesses. During the Technical Session the Applicant's witnesses will be available for questions as follows: Ronald Anstey is the only witness scheduled for this session.

2. Order of Inquiry. The order of inquiry shall be as follows:

- i. Lewis Buttolph Spring Intervenors**
- ii. Mark Watson**
- iii. Town of Rumney**
- iv. Counsel for the Public**
- v. Town of Groton**
- vi. Applicant**

Committee counsel will attempt to accommodate reasonable requests to adjust the order of inquiry.

3. Procedures. The Technical Session will be recorded verbatim. Inquiries shall be in a question form and shall not be argumentative. Repetitive questions or inquiries will not be allowed. Questions and inquires to witnesses should be limited to issues pertaining to the witness's field of expertise and pre-filed testimony. Questions regarding qualifications of witnesses will also be allowed. If a proper question or inquiry cannot be answered at the time of the Technical Session, the proffering party will provide a

response in writing within seven (7) days unless otherwise ordered or agreed.

4. Counsel for the Committee. Counsel for the Committee will mediate any disputes regarding inquiries and requests for information and will maintain a list of documents that should be provided to the parties after the technical session. To the extent that any party is aggrieved by the handling of any inquiry, question or document request, that party shall file an appropriate motion for discovery, objection to discovery or motion for a protective order. Said motions and/or objections shall be directed to the presiding officer and shall comply with the Committee's Procedural Rules and the pre-trial order issued in this docket.

Any party may bring a technical consultant to the session. The technical session will be recorded.

In addition the parties may also informally confer about outstanding issues in the docket and may informally discuss settlement, factual stipulations and scheduling matters.

The session is open to the public.
