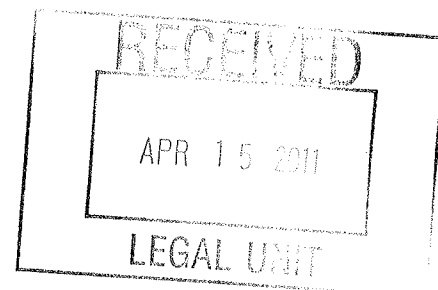

MOTION TO INTERVENE *PRO SE* OF JANICE D. LONGGOOD

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee Rules Site 202.11, Janice D. Longgood hereby moves for permission to intervene *pro se* in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of her Motion to Intervene, Janice D. Longgood offers the following arguments:

- (1.) Janice D. Longgood can demonstrate a substantial interest which may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding.**

My property abuts a portion of the leased land that Antrim Wind Energy LLC has proposed for development of the wind energy facility. I am extremely concerned about the noise, my health, property values and view shed. This proposed wind facility will have a negative impact on the environment in the rural conservation district and will forever change the landscape of an area that has been protected by covenants and zoning for many years. Additionally, I have been an appellant in proceedings before the Antrim Zoning Board of Adjustment regarding the met tower for this proposed facility.

- (2.) The interest of Janice D. Longgood will not be adequately protected by other parties.**

In exercising its discretion, I respectfully ask that the Committee consider whether the party's interest will be adequately protected by other parties. Since I, as a resident of the North Branch region of Antrim where the proposed wind facility would be constructed, do not feel that my interests and concerns have been addressed thus far in proceedings by the Selectmen and Planning Board of Antrim, I do not believe that any other party to this proceeding can adequately represent my interests in proceedings before the Committee.

- (3.) The intervention of Janice D. Longgood will be in the interest of justice and will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings by allowing the intervention.**

Pursuant to the SEC Order of March 21, 2011, Janice D. Longgood files this Motion to Intervene by the deadline set forth by the Committee for Docket 2011-02 and requests that I be permitted to intervene with full standing to participate in all phases and activities of the proceeding. I respect the importance of conducting this proceeding in an orderly manner that will not unduly delay the Committee or the parties in reaching an outcome. I am prepared to work closely with other parties to the proceeding in the interest of maintaining order and respectfully offer that my participation, if permitted, would be in the interest of justice.
