Q. Please state your name and address.

My name is Janice Duley Longgood, I reside at 156 Salmon Brook Road in Antrim, New Hampshire 03440.

Q. Are you familiar with the proposed Antrim Wind Energy, LLC project that is the subject of this docket:

I am familiar to the AWE project and have been involved as a citizen directly affected by the project living within ½ to ½ a mile from the proposed wind energy facility and am a direct abutter to land leased by AWE.
