Dear Ms. Murray:

I am writing on behalf of Antrim Wind Energy, LLC ("Antrim Wind") to request that the Site Evaluation Committee ("SEC") deliberate the outstanding issues in the above-captioned docket at the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing on Monday, June 27, 2011. Antrim Wind is in need of a decision on the Petitions for Jurisdiction filed by Antrim Wind and others as soon as possible so that it can determine whether to proceed with studies that must occur during the summer months. If the SEC grants the Petitions, the clarity afforded by the SEC process will enable Antrim Wind to proceed with such studies in a timely fashion and to file an application with the SEC by the end of this year as anticipated. In the absence of such a decision in the very near future, the project faces great uncertainty and may not go forward on schedule or even at all.


Antrim Wind's Petition for Jurisdiction was filed March 11, 2011. The Petition is akin to a Motion for Declaratory Ruling on the issue of jurisdiction which must be decided within 90 days. *See* N.H. Code Admin. Rule Site 203.02 (b) within 90 days. In these circumstances, Antrim Wind respectfully asks that the SEC deliberate the jurisdictional issue at the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing on June 27, 2011 and issue its written decision as soon as possible thereafter.
