I am writing to you in my capacity as outside counsel to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee. On January 31, 2012, Antrim Wind Energy, LLC, filed an Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility with the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee. The Application proposes to site and construct 10 wind energy turbines each have a name plate capacity of no more than 3 megawatts and standing up to 492 feet in height in the Town of Antrim, New Hampshire. Specifically, the project is proposed to be located on and adjacent to property at 354 Keene Road (N.H. Route 9) and includes approximately 1,850 acres of private lands. The lands occupy the area from Route 9 in Antrim southward to the east summit to Tuttle Hill, and to the north flank of Willard Mountain to the west. The project is proposed to be constructed primarily on the ridgeline that starts approximately 0.75 miles south of N.H. Route 9 and runs south southwest for approximately 2.5 miles. The project is located entirely within the Town of Antrim.

However, as an abutting community, your town may have an interest in the outcome of the Site Evaluation Committee's consideration of this Application. Therefore, pursuant to RSA 541-A:39, we are giving you notice of the filing of the Application. If the Application is determined to be administratively complete, the Site Evaluation Committee will issue and publish an Order of Notice scheduling public informational hearings and other matters pertaining to the Application.
