MOTION TO INTERVENE *PRO SE* OF KATHARINE ELIZABETH SULLIVAN

Pursuant to the N.H. Site Evaluation Committee Rules Site 202.11. Katharine Elizabeth Sullivan hereby moves for permission to intervene *pro se* in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of her Motion to Intervene, Katharine Elizabeth Sullivan offers the following arguments:

1. I [K.E. Sullivan] can demonstrate a substantial interest which may be affected by the outcome of the proceeding. Though not an abutter, my property is entirely surrounded by a major abutter, N.H. Audubon. My home will be well within the 2 mile zone in which occur numerous health effects resulting from noise, lights, and sub sonic pulse. My property value relies very much on the location of said property, and will be significantly impacted in a negative manner by the height and number of visible towers. My Grandmother's life work culminated in the creation of this wildlife sanctuary, the dePierrefeu Sanctuary,

which up until this time has been ably protected and managed by N.H. Audubon and N.H. Fish and Game. This area is a place of refuge to many people as well, from all over New England, as well as tourists from farther afield. It is a rare thing, a pristine environment, undeveloped and peaceful in Southern N.H. People have enjoyed the wildlife here for generations, children are educated in Biology and Ecology by the local school systems, and this Rural Conservation Zone has been a resource that cannot be replaced, and will most certainly be changed for all our lifetimes by an industrial scale wind project here.

- 2. In exercising its discretion, I respectfully ask that the Committee consider whether the interests of the people and wildlife within this zone will be protected in any measure by the town of Antrim, Aeolian Wind, Antrim Wind, or any other industry not accustomed to taking personal lives and histories into account when enthusiastically moving ahead with a project of this size.
- 3. The intervention of Katharine Elizabeth Sullivan will be in the interest of justice and will not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings by allowing the intervention.

Pursuant to the SEC Order of March 20,2012, I [Katharine Elizabeth Sullivan] file this Motion to INtervene by the deadline set forth by the Committee for Docket 2012-01 and request the I be permitted to intervene with full standing to participate in all phases and activities of the proceeding. I respect the importance of conducting this proceeding in an orderly manner that will not unduly delay the Committee or the parties in reaching an outcome. I am prepared

work closely with other parties to the proceeding in the interest of maintaining order and respectfully offer that my participation, if permitted, would be in the interest of justice.
