Dear Amy,

My parents and I live at 117 Salmon Brook Road in Antrim New Hampshire.

I would like to know if it is too late to voice our concerns over the proposed wind farm? They are both senior citizens and I feel the family was not aware of the procedures to be heard and was hoping I would have the chance to be called as a witness to testify about what I know about the land and what my objections are? I spent many hours over the years hiking in the area and have come across a number of things that will be impacted. I am not 100 percent sure but I think I discovered a native Indian burial ground? I explained what I found to a woman from Maine who was 80 years old who specializes in identifying such sites and she said that is what I found?

I never told anybody because I did not want the area disturbed because whatever is buried there has a right to rest in peace. She said the only way to be sure is to dig beside what I found and I will find more markers that are covered from hundreds or thousands of years of dirt built up and I did not want to do that so I never thought about it again until now. I recently watched a documentary called Wind Fall on Netflix and it basically follows the permitting process on film and then all the objections and impacts on the residents. I am a professional photographer and cinematographer and have worked on many films as an actor also. I have been taking photos around Antrim for years and will most likely put together a short film to show some great sites and put it up on utube so folks can really see what the place looks like. I have only been on a few sites explaining the wind farm and I have not seen any great quality images or video footage?

I am not sure what to do with this whole situation but I think it is too late to be considered at a formal proceeding? I really don't want this email in the public record so if you could keep it personal and confidential I would appreciate it. I can write a more formal one if allowed but I think my photos and a documentary will pretty much cover everything.
