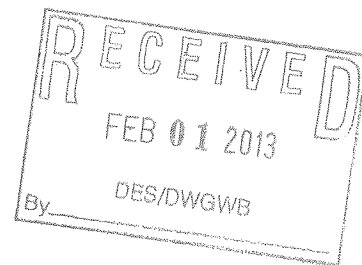

Application of Groton Wind, LLC for a Certificate of Site and Facility for a Renewable Energy Facility in Groton, N.H.

Background

On May 6, 2011, a duly appointed Subcommittee of the Site Evaluation Committee (Subcommittee) issued its Decision granting a Certificate of Site and Facility (Certificate) with conditions (Decision) to Groton Wind, LLC (Applicant), authorizing the construction and operation of a renewable energy facility (Facility or Project) consisting of 24 Gamesa G82 turbines each, having a nameplate capacity of 2 megawatts (MW), for a total nameplate capacity of 48 MW to be located in the Town of Groton, Grafton County, New Hampshire (Site). On October 14, 2011, the New Hampshire Supreme Court issued an order declining to review the Decision on appeal.

The Applicant subsequently commenced construction of the Facility.

On December 31, 2012, the Committee received a copy of a letter from the Selectmen of the Town of Rumney to the Applicant concerning cold patch repairs required on Groton Hollow Road in Rumney. The letter referenced an oral agreement and reminded the Applicant that permanent repairs were required to be made at the expense of the Applicant in the spring of 2013. In addition, the letter reminded the Applicant that an engineer's inspection and report on the condition of Groton Hollow Road was required at the conclusion of construction.

On December 31, 2012, the Committee also received a letter from the Selectmen of Rumney expressing concerns about the Applicant's maintenance of the Site, reimbursable expenses incurred by the Town, and poor communication with the Town. On January 11, 2013 and January 14, 2013, the Applicant delivered letters to the Committee responding to the concerns raised by the Town.

At this time it is unclear as to whether the Applicant's responses resolved the concerns raised by the Rumney Selectmen.

On January 14, 2013, James Buttolph on behalf of certain intervenors in this docket filed a letter with the Committee asking the Committee to re-open the record. In support of his request Mr. Buttolph alleges that the construction of the project did not comport with the plans as approved by the Committee and that there were significant revisions to the plans specifically regarding the location of the operation and maintenance building and the location of two wind turbines. Mr. Buttolph also asserts that the revisions to the planned facility were outside of the purview of the wetlands permit conditions and the alteration of terrain permit conditions.

On January 16, 2013, the Applicant responded to Mr. Buttolph's letter in response the Applicant asserts that the revisions to the plans and the facility as constructed were properly submitted to the Department of Environmental Services as modifications or amendments to the wetlands permit and the alteration of terrain permit. The Applicant asserts that further review by the Committee was unnecessary under the terms of the Certificate.

The issues raised by the letter from Mr. Buttolph and the response from the Applicant may need resolution by the Committee.

Authority for the Hearing

Pursuant to RSA 162-H: 4, I (c) the Committee has the obligation and authority to monitor the construction and operation of any energy facility that is subject to the terms and conditions of a certificate of

Background

On December 21, 2012, Timbercop Wind 1, LLC (Petitioner) filed a Petition for Jurisdiction with the Committee. The Petitioner proposes to site, construct, and operate a wind energy facility on Kidder Mountain in the towns of Temple and New Ipswich, Hillsborough County, N.H. The Petitioner plans to site and construct a total of five wind turbines, two in New Ipswich and three in Temple. As currently configured, the facility would consist of five (5) Siemens SWT turbines each having a nameplate capacity of 3 MW. The total nameplate capacity for the facility would be 15 MW. The Petitioner proposes to interconnect the facility to the Public Service Company of New Hampshire distribution circuit #3235.

The Petitioner asserts that the facility will have a nameplate capacity of more than 5 MW but less than 30 MW and requests that the Committee exercise jurisdiction over the siting, construction and operation of the facility pursuant to RSA 162-H: 2, XII (petition of the applicant).

Petition for Jurisdiction over a Renewable Energy Facility Proposed by Timbertop Wind I, LLC, to be Located in Temple and New Ipswich NH

Background

On December 21, 2012, Timberlop Wind I, LLC (Petitioner) filed a Petition for Jurisdiction (Petition). The Petitioner proposes to site, construct, and operate a wind energy facility on Kidder Mountain in the towns of Temple and New Ipswich, Hillsborough County N.H. The Petitioner plans to site and construct a total of five wind turbines, two in New Ipswich and three in Temple. As currently configured the facility would consist of five (5) Siemens SWT turbines each having a nameplate capacity of 3 MW. The total nameplate capacity for the facility would be 15 MW. The Petitioner proposes to interconnect the facility to the Public Service Company of New Hampshire distribution circuit #3235.

The Petition asserts that the facility will have a nameplate capacity of more than 5 MW but less than 30 MW and requests that the Committee exercise jurisdiction over the siting, construction and operation of the Facility pursuant to RSA 162-H:2,XII (petition of the applicant).

Authority for Hearing

The Committee's authority to undertake this proceeding is set forth at RSA 162-H:2, XII, RSA 162-H: 4, and N.H. CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES, Site 203.01. The Committee must determine if it is consistent with the findings and purposes of RSA 162-H: 1 to assert jurisdiction over the proposed facility and require that the Petitioner file an application for a certificate of site and facility. See, RSA 162-H:2,XII.

Intervention and Public Comment

Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file a motion to intervene on or before February 8, 2013. Motions to intervene should comply with the requirements of N.H. CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE RULES, Site

Town.

At this time it is unclear as to whether the Applicant's responses resolved the concerns raised by the Rumney Selectmen.

On January 14, 2013, James Buttolph on behalf of certain intervenors in this docket filed a letter with the Committee asking the Committee to re-open the record. In support of his request. Mr. Buttolph alleges that the construction of the project did not comport with the plans as approved by the Committee and that there were significant revisions to the plans specifically regarding the location of the operation and maintenance building and the location of two wind turbines. Mr. Buttolph also asserts that the revisions to the planned facility were outside of the purview of the wetlands permit conditions and the alteration of terrain permit conditions.

On January 16, 2013, the Applicant responded to Mr. Buttolph's letter. In response the Applicant asserts that the revisions to the plans and the facility as constructed were properly submitted to the Department of Environmental Services as modifications or amendments to the wetlands permit and the alteration of terrain permit. The Applicant asserts that further review by the Committee was unnecessary under the terms of the Certificate.

The issues raised by the letter from Mr. Buttolph and the response from the Applicant may need resolution by the Committee.

Authority for the Hearing

Pursuant to RSA 162-H: 4,I (c) the Committee has the obligation and authority to monitor the construction and operation of any energy facility that is subject to the terms and conditions of a certificate of site and facility. The Committee is also empowered to enforce the terms and conditions of a certificate of site and facility. RSA 162-H:4 I, (d). The Committee is authorized to hold hearings as it deems necessary and appropriate. RSA 162-H:4,II.

At the hearing the Committee will review the claims of the Town of Rumney, the intervenors and the Applicant and determine whether further monitoring or enforcement measures are necessary.

Application of Groton Wind, LLC for a Certificate of Site and Facility for a Renewable Energy Facility in Groton, N.H.

Background

On May 6, 2011, a duly appointed Subcommittee of the Site Evaluation Committee (Subcommittee) issued its Decision granting a Certificate of Site and Facility (Certificate) with conditions (Decision) to Groton Wind, LLC (Applicant), authorizing the construction and

operation of a renewable energy facility (Facility or Project) consisting of 24 Gamesa G82 turbines each having a nameplate capacity of 2 megawatts (MW), for a total nameplate capacity of 48 MW to be located in the Town of Groton, Grafton County, New Hampshire (Site). On October 14, 2011, the New Hampshire Supreme Court issued an order declining to review the Decision on appeal.

The Applicant subsequently commenced construction of the Facility.

On December 31, 2012, the Committee received a copy of a letter from the Selectmen of the Town of Rumney to the Applicant concerning cold patch repairs required on Groton Hollow Road in Rumney. The letter referenced an oral agreement and reminded the Applicant that permanent repairs were required to be made at the expense of the Applicant in the spring of 2013. In addition the letter reminded the Applicant that an engineer's inspection and report on the condition of Groton Hollow Road was required at the conclusion of construction.

On December 31, 2012 the Committee also received a letter from the Selectmen of Rumney expressing concerns about the Applicant's maintenance of the Site, reimbursable expenses incurred by the Town, and poor communication with the Town. On January 11, 2013,



Light boxes to brighten veteran home

Tilton | Donations will lead to the construction of solar cafe for residents.

CONCORD — New Hampshire winters can be long and dark, but residents at the state nursing home for veterans may soon be looking on the bright side with the installation of a so-called solar cafe built around donated light boxes.

"We have noticed a rather high prevalence of depression in the elderly, which certainly goes along with the health problems and emotional losses that older people experience, and we've also noticed that seasonal affective disorder can be a component," she said. "We're really want to treat their depression with an

purchased 13 medical light boxes for the home, which is figuring out how best to use them.

The psychiatrist who visits the home once a week has suggested creating a solar cafe where residents and staff could gather for coffee, doughnuts, activities and light therapy, said nurse practitioner Janna Prendiville.

"We have noticed a rather high prevalence of depression in the elderly, which certainly goes along with the health problems and emotional losses that older people experience, and we've also noticed that seasonal affective disorder can be a component," she said. "We're really want to treat their depression with an

antidepressant if needed, and use the light box as an adjunct, to help with people's energy level, alertness during the day and ultimately help them sleep better at night."

Seasonal affective disorder, also called SAD, is a kind of depression that occurs at a certain time of the year, usually in the winter. Four to 6 percent of people in the United States suffer from it, and another 10 to 20 percent may experience a mild form of winter-onset SAD, the American Academy of Family Physicians estimates.

Treatment often involves sitting in front of a special lamp with a very bright light that mimics sunlight for 20-30 minutes each day. That could be particularly effective for patients with dementia who might not have the attention span for longer alternative treatments, Prendiville said,

but she expects most of the home's 200 or so residents could benefit from it in some way.

It was serendipitous that the light boxes were donated just in time for winter, and at a time when the nursing home industry as a whole is assessing whether medication is always the best choice for depression and other psychiatric ailments, said Barry Conway, commandant of the veterans home.

"It's not going to be a silver bullet, but it's going to

be a big help," he said.

Ross Houston, the general manager of Laconia Harley-Davidson, said he was a bit surprised when officials at the home put light boxes at the top of their wish list. He moved to New Hampshire three years ago after growing in Texas, where seasonal affective disorder is less common. But once he learned more about the issue, he was thrilled to be able to help.

About a third of Harley-Davidson riders are veterans, and the shop in Meredith has made a point of supporting veterans' causes over the years, Houston said.

"We owe it to these folks to recognize the efforts they've made and make their lives more comfortable," he said. "It's a wonderful feeling to know people are going to get the help they need."

Climber ID'd in NH fall

RANDOLPH (AP) — New Hampshire authorities are identifying the hiker who fell to his death during an outing near Mount Adams as a 64-year-old man from University Park, Texas.

The Fish and Game Department says Richard Gabrielle was near the top of what's known as the Great Gully in King's Ravine when he lost his footing and fell down the ravine, near Randolph, on Saturday afternoon.

Officials said Sunday that Gabrielle tumbled more than 1,500 feet down the steep slope before coming to rest, and sustained significant injuries that killed him instantly.

Conrad met with the committee two weeks ago to discuss the challenges that will face the board this budget period. He also talked with the committee about what it would take to lower class sizes in the city, particularly at the elementary level.

Conrad has said that budgeting will be more difficult this year because of the way the state now calculates aid equity aid. While the district will get an estimate of its aid amount this fiscal year, that number could change part way through next year, once the budget

is set and money is already being spent.

The district also has multiple contract negotiations ongoing during the budget process, including teacher, paraeducator, custodial and secretarial contracts.

Monday's meeting will be held at Board Street Elementary School, beginning

at 6:45 p.m. The meeting will start with a tour of the school by school officials.
