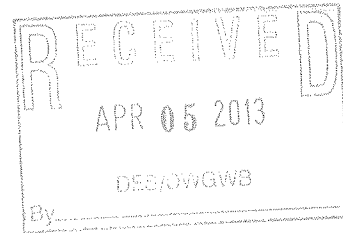


Dear Jane,
