Subject: Moratorium for Energy Generation Projects

Dear Administrator Drew,

It has come to my attention that there is currently under consideration a moratorium on new energy generation projects in New Hampshire. I would like to respectfully ask for your support for a moratorium on wind turbine projects in New Hampshire. With the existing activity in the lakes region, and more particular in the Newfound Lake area (most recently the Wild Meadows Wind project proposed for Alexandria, Danbury, and Grafton), the impact that this, and other projects being contemplated (reference attached), will have on the natural landscape is of major concern.

New Hampshire has many outstanding unique natural qualities which are being threatened by insufficiently regulated projects that are not being given full consideration as to their impacts on our natural resources, wildlife, the surrounding communities, and the anticipated impacts on tourism throughout the State.

As I am convinced that the negative impacts of these projects require significantly greater review, I strongly support a moratorium. I hope that I can rely on your support as well.
