We would like to request your support for a moratorium on wind turbine projects in New Hampshire, especially the Wild Meadows Wind project, and other wind turbine projects in the scenic Newfound Lake area.

Located approximately 20 miles west of Meredith, Newfound Lake was the only lake in New Hampshire selected in a poll of the best small lakes in North America, according to a **U.S.A. Today** poll released in late summer.

We understand there is consideration of a moratorium on new energy projects, triggered by HB648 and the Northern Pass project.

It is concerning to us that this substantial development is being considered with minimal notice to the people in this area who are going to be impacted.

We am not opposed to "green", but loudly opposed to "greed".  
Wind Turbine projects mostly benefit the developer.

We are requesting this moratorium be considered as we have strong concerns related to the negative impact this will have on our local economy and public health of our community,  
as well as the impact on the Newfound watershed and wildlife environment.

The negative consequences of industrial wind turbines far outweigh the benefits, especially in the scenic and tourist environment of New Hampshire's lake region.
