Subject: Industrial scale wind farms for the Lakes Region.

We would like to express our strong objection to development of large scale wind projects in the Lakes Region. Use of wind as a supplementary energy source is clearly important, but there are appropriate locations for and means of development. Allowing foreign corporations to exploit New Hampshire's natural resources for private gain at the expense of the greater public good is not appropriate. Large industrial windmills on every high point of land will seriously degrade the scenic beauty of the Lakes Region, reduce property values, and negatively impact the tourist industry by placing New Hampshire at a serious disadvantage to states that are better stewards of their natural resources.

We urge you to use all possible means to place reasonable limits on industrial wind energy development that preserve the character, natural beauty, and tourist economy of New Hampshire.
