We have grave concerns regarding the health, safety, financial and environmental impacts of the proposed Wild Meadows Industrial Wind Turbine Project (proposed by Iberdoria Renewables) and other industrial wind projects in our state, and support statewide efforts to protect New Hampshire communities from the industrial wind turbines.


We have done our own research into these projects finding the negative impacts on communities and the environment completely ignored, while the positive benefits are completely negated by the impacts. None of these wind projects can be built nor considered viable without massive fossil fuels spent or held in reserve when the wind isn't sufficient. The environmental impact on wildlife and humans is documented but ignored.

Economic benefits only exist in the shifting of tax burdens from other tax payers to subsidize this industry. Danbury is about to venture into that subsidized economy as we get the windfall of incremental revenue. The Town of Danbury and the residents will be held accountable when those subsidies fall out of fashion.

We respectfully ask that you consider an immediate moratorium on the Wild Meadows Wind Power Project and all future wind turbine projects in New Hampshire. We are the growing public support for this view in our town and across the state of New Hampshire.
