Dear Commissioner Burack & SEC Committee Members,

In reference to Iberdrola's newest proposed industrial wind plant {"Wild Meadows"} in the Newfound Lake region, there are two items to bring to your attention on the attached document regarding Iberdrola's existing {Groton} industrial wind plant in the Newfound Lake region:

1} Iberdrola's Ed Cherian is explicitly clear here about honoring the wishes of local towns that vote to oppose Iberdrola's turbine projects. {#4}

He stated it for the record re Groton but appears to now have amnesia regarding "Wild Meadows" which has been resoundingly rejected by voters and in town meetings.

2} Mr. Cherian states here that "bigger turbines have bigger impacts". He rejects their use for Groton due to "bigger impacts." {#13}

The same Ed Cherian is now saying these "bigger impact" taller turbines are a plus for "Wild Meadows."

Clearly there are some significant operating issues in Groton that appear to many to be seriously impacting public health and safety. It appears that Iberdrola did not implement the plan as approved on the Certificate if I understand the transcripts correctly.

As you consider this pending new application, please consider the history of the current Iberdrola installation along with Mr. Cherian's statements as recorded in the enclosed document.
