Hi Tim,

As part of the vetting process the SEC does on any future Iberdrola industrial wind applications, can you please request:

1} That Iberdrola disclose any and all "Good Neighbor Contracts" they have in NH or in any neighboring state NH exports energy to.

It is our understanding that these alleged contracts involve an upfront payment followed by monthly payments.

It is our understanding that these alleged contracts are given to impacted residents in order to ensure they remain mute regarding noise and health issues involving Iberdrola installed mechanized turbines.

2} That the SEC verify that any and all pictures Iberdrola has taken or commissioned for the "Wild Meadows" industrial turbine project were taken on property that Iberdrola/ its subsidiaries or independent contractors retained by Iberdrola had obtained permission to access with the owner's knowledge that Iberdrola was on his/her property.

We would like to request that the SEC put Iberdrola officials under oath and ask about both of these topics.

I am not suggesting Iberdrola is guilty of any infraction and I cannot confirm the existence of "Good Neighbor Contracts" definitively; but I would like to request that the SEC include both of these topics in your diligence for "Wild Meadows."

After the alleged Iberdrola infractions in Groton.....it seems doubly important to get all the key facts upfront.
