I was recently made aware of a December 22, 2013 email letter filed with the NH Site Evaluation Committee that was signed Ms. Shirley Felong of Danbury, NH.

You may be aware that this letter appears to be written by Iberdrola and was apparently submitted via an Iberdrola Renewables website. Please see: http://iberdrolarenewables.us/wildmeadows/send-support-letter.html.

While Iberdrola is entitled to campaign for its project, the public should be made aware that the company's advocacy letter makes statements that are inconsistent with the information submitted in the above referenced matter. Specifically, Iberdrola's letter claims the project will reduce CO2 emissions by 340 million pounds a year (170,000 short tons) but the project application states CO2 emissions will be reduced by 130,983 short tons. (Wild Meadows Wind application, Section 1, page 78).
