I am writing to strongly object to the Turbine Wind Project proposed for Alexandria NH, Danbury NH and the Newfound Lakes region with the following thoughts in mind.

I have examined the plans for the proposed wind turbines on the Wild Meadows site with considerable interest and feel the project will be environmentally detrimental to Alexandria, Danbury and the Newfound Lakes region.

As an owner of property on the lake, I am very much interested in preserving the beauty and natural landscape of the Newfound Lake area and any new or proposed landscape changes to our pristine lakes region as with the Turbine Wind Project plan will have severe consequences that will permanently damage the landscape that surrounds the lake.

Almost all of the developments in the area that I have been aware of have had to address some form of “visual amenity” issues and the town planning board, developers and planners alike usually have to examine these projects closely. Apparently this is not being done here. It does not take a rocket scientist to see how harmful this Turbine Wind Project will be to the beauty that surrounds Newfound Lake. In the case of the proposed wind turbines at Wild Meadows in Alexandria and Danbury, no amount of tree planting or landscaping could possibly mitigate the massive visual effect that these large structures will have on the local landscape and views from the lake. Not to mention the “Red Flashing Lights” at night glimmering across the lake and the demonstrated slaughter of birds and bats that fly into these turbines.

The SEC has the power and responsibility to prevent this carnage and permanent damage to the pristine and beautiful Newfound Lakes region, an area that attracts visitors to its lake shores from all over the United States and brings in needed tourist revenue to the State of New Hampshire. I hope that the members of the SEC exercise their inherent responsibility to preserve the nature and beauty of the lakes region area and enact a permanent ban on these Wind Turbine projects going forward.

For aesthetic, noise pollution and environmental reasons, the Wild Meadows wind turbine project in Alexandria and Danbury, NH should be rejected.
