I am writing to express my support for the proposed rules that were drafted by the NH Site Evaluation Committee (SEC) after much public input and careful consideration. I believe the proposed rules by the SEC are a good balance of the many complex issues that must be taken into account in the matter of siting large-scale energy projects. There was very extensive public and industry input during the year long process and I believe the rules as drafted reflect the best thinking of the SEC after much deliberation.

The issues and questions raised by JLCARs are very specific and their inquiries should not be construed as an opportunity to renegotiate the standards that were proposed by the SEC. Your committee is closest to the issues and has had the benefit of months of testimony and other public and industry input.

I believe that the intent of the law as drafted required a net benefit approach to the SEC's deliberations and once that issue is communicated to JLCARs, I hope that you will stay the course and approve the rules as drafted.
