Supplemental Non-Applicant Testimony of Richard Dipentima

Could you please identify yourself?

I am Richard DiPentima and I reside with my wife Catherine at 16 Dunlin Way, Portsmouth, New Hampshire. I am one of the so-called "Portsmouth Intervenors" in this matter, and filed my pre-filed testimony earlier in this matter. This testimony supplements my earlier testimony.

What is the purpose of this Supplemental Testimony?

This supplemental testimony will largely comment on evidence received by the Commission, or which has been submitted over the past few weeks and months.

Over the past few weeks and months, I have noticed that letters have been submitted by numerous people, purporting to support the Sea-3 request for an exemption from the certification requirements of RSA 162-H. In the course of my review of these letters, I have noticed a similarity and sometimes identity between and among the various letters, suggesting that these letters are the product of an organized campaign to support the Sea-3 application.

Many of the letters are unsigned. Many of the letters have nearly the exact text, or the exact text, as other letters. Nearly all of the letters fail to provide any background on the person purporting to send them. And all of the purported letter writers are from towns other than Portsmouth (or in fact, any of the communities that might be affected by increased rail traffic, transloading and distribution of propane).

I must confess that I find it strange that these letters could have any evidentiary value to the Commission, particularly where the text is identical, no background on the person sending the letter is included, and the letter is unsigned.

I did not realize that the Commission would be accepting letters from people in support or adverse to the Sea-3 exemption request. In view of the recent, seemingly orchestrated group of identical and mostly unsigned letters, I would like the Commission to review the Petition attached to this supplemental testimony as Exhibit A.

Can you please describe what is attached as Exhibit A?

Yes. Exhibit A is made up of two things. First, there is the written transcript of my testimony before the Portsmouth City Council, which describes the context in which the signature on the petition were sought, and the manner in which we received the signatures of nearly 600

Portsmouth residents. Second, after my testimony or remarks are true and correct copies of the actual Petitions with signatures.

And what is the purpose of the Petition?

The Petition states as follows:

“Considering that the Town of Newington, NH Planning Board has refused to conduct the appropriate Safety and Environmental Impact Studies requested by the City of Portsmouth with regard to the Sea-3 expansion proposal, we the undersigned residents of Portsmouth, NH request that the City Council vote to appeal to the Superior Court in Rockingham County within 30 days of any decision by the Town of Newington Planning Board to approve the Sea-3 expansion proposal.”

We presented the Petitions at the Post Office, the Portsmouth Saturday Farmers’ Market, the Osprey Landing Center, the Spinnaker Point Clubhouse, and through door-to-door visits with residents. We garnered something on the order of 600 signatures in less than a week. The signatures include a State Senator, the former Speaker of the New Hampshire House of Representatives, local business owners, and hundreds of residents of the City – and not merely folks who live along the Pan Am Railways line leading into Newington and the Sea-3 facility. The Petition was, I believe, successful, in that the City Council voted to devote the resources and time to appealing the Planning Board decision.

But more importantly, the Petition effort demonstrated that many ordinary citizens of the City considered the Sea-3 project – and, it is true, the logistics associated with it – a significant threat to the quality of life in Portsmouth, and believed that the Newington Planning Board had deliberately omitted an important evaluation of the safety of the expansion project.

Why, in your judgment, is the Petition (and signatures) important for the Site Evaluation Committee to consider?

The “signature drive” was a real effort by ordinary citizens to get the public and city leadership to understand the seriousness of the expansion proposal, and the concomitant increase in rail traffic through the City as a whole. The Petition drive stands in marked contrast to the “public relations” campaign that is apparently being conducted by Sea-3 now, which has resulted in small deluge of textually identical, unsigned and, I would suggest, largely uninformed letters that have recently been submitted to the Committee.

We now know that Sea-3 has apparently hired a media strategy company called “Purple Strategies,” an organization based in Alexandria, Virginia and Boston, Massachusetts. We have made a request (a “data request”) for more information about this company and its role in helping Sea-3 to produce favorable letters favorable to the expansion project.

We believe that the Petition and signatures appear in stark contrast to a media relations campaign; our efforts then and now are simply to generate awareness of the expansion project, the potential downside consequences of the project, and to ensure that appropriate safety, health,

environmental and emergency response plans are considered and are in place in advance of any approval. We believe that these goals can be best and most appropriately accomplished by denying the requested exemption and having Sea-3 go through the certification process contemplated by the statute.

Have you reviewed the report submitted by Sebago Technics in this matter?

Yes.

Do you have concerns that the safety study conducted by Sebago Technics did not fully address all the comprehensive safety and emergency response issues presented by the Sea-3 expansion proposal and their request for an exemption to the full RSA 162:H process?

The other Portsmouth Intervenors and I appreciate the limitations presented to Sebago Technics as to the scope of their study and the financial limitations that narrowed the scope of their study. But I and others continue to have serious concerns regarding the gaps that remain unanswered regarding the safety issues surrounding the Sea-3 expansion.

The Sebago Technics study, because of the limitations noted, was not (and again, didn't pretend to be) a fully comprehensive study evaluating the complete range of emergency response issues that need to be addressed and fully vetted by the Site Evaluation Committee. We note that the Sebo Technics witnesses, in their pre-filed testimony, expressed two concerns, as follows:

“While additional facilities at Sea-3 and increased traffic on the Track may raise additional and increased safety risks, we cannot opine about those due to a lack of operating history and a clear understanding of the reconfigured project....

Of primary concern at present is that first responders in the area lack adequate training, resources and coordination to effectively respond to much more than a minor incident at the facility or on the Track.”

Pre-Filed Testimony of Stephen Sawyer, Frederick Fraini and Robert Davids, at page 2 (emphasis added).

What questions not reviewed or answered by the Sebago Technics' study need, in your view, to be evaluated and answered?

We think in the course of a complete and comprehensive certification process under RSA 162-H, Sea-3's proposed expansion would have to pose and answer the following questions:

- Does the Town of Newington, either in conjunction with the applicant or in its own right, possess emergency evacuation plans; were those plans reviewed by specialists in the field; and if not, why not?
- If emergency evacuation plans exist, and if they were reviewed by experts in the relevant discipline, was there a review of exercises conducted to test these plans?

- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, evaluate and test notification system(s) of those businesses and population centers within the one (1) mile evacuation zone of an emergency requiring evacuation?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, conducted a Blast (BTU) analysis of any explosion at Sea-3 that would quantify the explosion potential in terms of kilo-ton levels and what impact such an explosion would have on the Sea-3 storage tanks and surrounding facilities such as Sprague Energy?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, conducted any gap analysis on the Sea-3 or Town of Newington emergency response capabilities/plans?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, reviewed or evaluated the Montpelier, Vermont report and the need to develop evacuation plans for transportation of propane?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, evaluated the report of the increased rail traffic resulting from the Sea-3 expansion and the safety inspection of offloading 5,000 tank cars per year?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, develop basic planning scenarios to frame an analysis of emergency response, which range from moderate to worst case?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, evaluated the critical infrastructure interdependencies that could impact the infrastructure, plus the implication of cascading failure?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, conducted a vulnerability assessment to determine which of the identified hazards are likely to impact the facility or surrounding area in a way that could result in a facility-related incident?
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, conducted a phased risk evaluation to assess different levels of risk, such as “threat,” “vulnerability,” “likelihood” and “consequence, as defined below”?
 - Threat = Accident, noticed or intentional
 - Vulnerability = any weakness in the system or asset that can be exploited by a threat source.
 - Likelihood = such threats in terms of probability or frequency.
 - Consequence = what will happen to the asset and organization on a whole.
- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, conducted a risk assessment when the combination of likelihood and consequence were evaluated?

- Has anyone, including but not limited to the applicant, conducted a gap analysis to evaluate any of the following:
 - Fire Department response capabilities, initial aid portion and regional capabilities?
 - Local and Regional EMS capabilities?
 - Local and Regional Hospital and Trauma Center capabilities?
 - Review of current emergency operations plans for the facility, the community and surrounding jurisdictions, including so-called Continuity of Operations and Business Continuity Management?
 - Evaluation of Special Response Units (Search and Rescue, HazMat, etc.)?

These are questions which, to my judgment, remain unanswered by the applicant, by the planning board process, and by any expert opinion. More importantly, these are questions and issues that could and should be properly posed, evaluated and understood in the course of a proper certification process involving each of the disciplines contemplated under RSA 162-H:7-a.

Rich DiPentima, 16 Dunlin Way, Portsmouth. Mr. Mayor, this evening we expect that the Newington Planning Board will approve the Sea-3 expansion proposal. As such, I am here today to present the Council with the following petition; Considering that the Town of Newington Planning Board has refused to conduct the appropriate safety and environmental impact studies requested by the City of Portsmouth with regard to the Sea-3 expansion proposal, we the undersigned residents of Portsmouth request that the City Council vote to appeal to the Superior Court in Rockingham County within 30 days of any decision by the Town of Newington Planning Board to approve the Sea-3 expansion proposal.

In only six days we were able to have this petition signed by 598 Portsmouth residents (533 in person, 65 on-line), 33 business operators, 35 individuals from other abutter towns, and 24 other individuals, for a total of 699 signatures. This includes our State Senator, The Speaker of the NH House and two other State Reps. Of note are comments made by members of the business community who signed the petition, such as Rob Cartwright, CEO of Northern Hospitality, who agrees that the railway and Harborcorp couldn't coexist. Chris Moulton, Gen. Mgr Residence Inn Downtown Portsmouth wrote, "I do not want this at all." The level of concern expressed by many individuals and business owners we spoke with is amazing. People cannot believe that Portsmouth would allow Portsmouth to be placed at such a risk.

According to RSA 677:15 Any persons aggrieved by any decision of the planning board may present to the superior court a petition, setting forth that such a decision is illegal or unreasonable. The petition shall be presented to the court within 30 days after the date upon which the board voted to approve the application. We believe that the Newington Planning Board's approval of this project is in violation of their own Site Plan Review Regulations that require that they protect public health, safety and welfare, and to avoid any development that

may harm the environment. In the absence of comprehensive safety and security and environmental impact studies, such as was conducted in MA with regard to a similar project there, the Newington Planning Board lacks all the information necessary to assure that they have protected the public health, safety and security of the residents of Portsmouth, and other abutter communities.

The 30 day clock will start tomorrow. We urge the Council to respect the wishes of the hundreds of residents of Portsmouth, business owners and others and file the requested appeal of the Newington Planning Board's approval of the Sea-3 expansion project. We should know the results of their meeting before you take up Asst Mayor Splaine's agenda item later in this meeting
