Dear Mr. Penacho:

I am writing to you in my capacity as counsel to the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee (Committee).

On January 8, 2015 SEA-3, Inc. (SEA-3) filed a petition entitled Request for Exemption from the Approval and Certification Requirements of RSA Chapter 162-H by SEA-3, Inc. A copy of the Request is enclosed. After review, the Chairman of the Committee requested additional information from SEA-3. On February 27, 2015, SEA-3 supplemented its filing. On March 26, 2015 the Chairman of the Committee determined that the Request along with the supplemental filing provided sufficient information for the Committee to consider the Request. A copy of an Order and Notice of Public Hearing, Acceptance of Request and Procedural Order is enclosed.

SEA-3 currently owns and operates a propane storage and distribution facility located at 162 Shattuck Way in Newington, N.H. The SEA-3 facility was sited, constructed and currently operates pursuant to an exemption from the requirements of NHRSA 162-H which was granted by the Committee in 1995.

SEA-3 now seeks to make sizable changes and additions to the facility. SEA-3 seeks to construct five additional rail unloading berths, three 90,000 gallon above ground storage tanks, a condenser, condenser cooling unit, dryer and heater, mechanical building, refrigeration equipment and associated pipelines and accessory equipment. The purpose of the proposed improvements is to facilitate the off-loading, processing and distribution of liquid propane gas delivered to the facility by rail-car.

In considering the Request the Committee must consider the requirements set forth in NHRSA 162-H:4, IV. A public hearing will be held on the Request will be held at the Newington Town Offices on May 7, 2015 at 6 PM.
