- 1 Q. Please state your name and address.
- 2 A. My name is Kim Eric Hazarvartian and my address is TEPP LLC, 93 Stiles Road, Suite
- 3 201, Salem, New Hampshire 03079.
- 4 Q. How are you employed?
- 5 A. I am principal engineer with TEPP LLC.
- 6 Q. What is your educational background and qualifications?
- 7 A. I specialize in transportation impacts of land developments, traffic operations and traffic
- 8 safety, accident and litigation support. I have consulting, academic, or government sector
- 9 experience since 1981 in these and other areas. I am a licensed Professional Engineer in the
- 10 State of New Hampshire and a certified Professional Traffic Operations Engineer. I hold a
- Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the University of Kansas, a Master of Science in
- 12 Civil Engineering from the University of Kansas and a Doctor of Philosophy in Civil
- 13 Engineering, specializing in transportation, from the University of Massachusetts.
- I have served as International Director for Northeastern District (District 1) of the
- 15 Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) as well as Chairman of ITE District 1, President of
- the ITE New England Section and President of the ITE New Hampshire Chapter. I am also
- 17 affiliated with the American Society of Civil Engineers, Transportation Research Board, Society

- 1 of American Military Engineers, Chi Epsilon national civil engineering honor society and Sigma
- 2 Xi scientific research society.
- 3 Q Has TEPP LLC been retained by SEA-3, Inc.?
- 4 A. Yes.
- 5 Q. What was TEPP LLC hired to do?
- 6 A. TEPP LLC was hired to prepare a Traffic Assessment Memorandum regarding propane
- 7 transport-truck traffic related to SEA-3's proposed expansion.
- 8 Q. I'm showing you a document that's been marked KEH Exhibit 1, can you identify
- 9 this document?
- 10 A. Yes, this is a copy of TEPP LLC's Traffic Assessment Memorandum dated March 24,
- 11 2014, that I prepared for submission to the Newington Planning Board.
- 12 Q. What is your understanding of the proposed expansion?
- 13 A. The Sea-3, Inc. facility encompasses a transportation terminal that includes three
- 14 components:
- water-side, with bulk transport of LPG in vessels
- rail-side, with bulk transport of LPG in rail cars
- land-side, with bulk transport of LPG in transport trucks
- 18 The proposed site-plan modifications involve an expansion of the terminal's rail-side capacity to
- increase SEA-3's access to the domestic propane market.
- 20 Q. Has SEA-3 proposed any changes to the facility's truck loading rack?
- A. No, SEA-3 has proposed no changes to the truck loading rack.
- 22 **Q.** Will the proposed improvements affect the capacity of the truck loading rack?

- 1 A. No, the proposed site-plan modifications do not materially affect the transport-truck land-
- 2 side component.
- 3 Q. Are you aware of the facility's historical truck volumes?
- 4 A. Yes.
- 5 Q. How far back?
- 6 A. Back to the year 2002.
- 7 Q. Will the proposed improvements allow the facility to exceed that volume?
- 8 A. Approximate average daily transport trucks per peak-month operating day is not
- 9 anticipated to exceed the historical range. In any event, the land-side transport-truck
- 10 configuration will not change and it limits the number of trucks that can be filled with liquefied
- petroleum gas to about 10 per hour.
- 12 Q. Since preparing the Traffic Assessment Memorandum that has been marked as
- 13 KEH Exhibit 1, have you learned any additional information that would cause you to
- 14 change the conclusions set forth in the Memorandum?
- 15 A. No.
