This letter is to notify you that DES Water Division staff have completed their determination as to whether or not the above referenced application contains sufficient information for the DES to conduct their technical review to consider the issuance of permits, conditions, or licenses under the jurisdiction of DES. The following list contains the program application numbers as well as the completeness determination:

- 1. Alteration of Terrain Permit Application No. 151020-172 complete
- 2. Wetland Permit Application No. 2015-02783 incomplete: lack of wetland mitigation proposal
- 3. Individual Subsurface Disposal System Application No. 201504487 complete

With regards to 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC), the application is considered complete based on the expectation that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) will determine that the State Programmatic General 404 Permit (SPGP), and the 401 WQC issued for the SPGP, applies to this project. If, however, the ACOE decides that the project requires an Individual 404 Permit (which is not considered likely at this time), the application is not complete until the Applicant submits an application for 401 WQC to the DES Watershed Management Bureau.
