MOTION TO STRIKE POST-HEARING BRIEF MADE BY ANTRIM WIND LLC

The Meteorological Intervenors respectfully move the NH Site Evaluation Committee to strike assertions made on pages 1 and 3 in their post-hearing brief, dated 30 November, as follows:

1 On page one, the statement “and all five bi-partisan state legislatures representing Antrim”.

2 On page three, the statement “to all four State Representatives and the State Senator”

There was an election on November 8, 2016, in which two seats for the four Antrim representative positions were strongly contested, and in which new representatives were elected, both of whom are opposed to the AWE development. In addition, a new senator was elected for the District, who also opposes the AWE development.

This election was the most recent referendum on “the support” from the Antrim legislators. The result was clear in the selection of new legislators who feelings were known to the voters. In fact one of the losers in the senatorial primary race made his feelings known in testimony before the Committee.

The two new Representatives and the new State Senator representing Antrim and surrounding Towns have sent letters to the Committee stating their opposition.

WHEREFORE, in view of this contrary information, the Meteorological Intervenors respectfully request that this Committee strike the two comments from the Applicant's post-hearing brief.
