In Case No. 2017-0313, Appeal of Mary Allen & a.; Appeal of Fred Ward, the court on July 31, 2017, issued the following order:

The motion for summary affirmance is denied. The appeal and the co-appeal from a decision of the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee are accepted and will be scheduled for oral argument before the full court. The request to suspend the appealed decision is denied. See RSA 541:18.

This case appears to be eligible for mediation pursuant to Rule 12-A. Under Rule 12-A(2), the agreement of all parties is required for appellate mediation. If all parties in this case agree to participate in mediation, the appellants shall submit the completed Appellate Mediation Agreement form to the court on or before August 15, 2017. An Appellate Mediation Agreement form (NHJB-2614-SUP) is being provided to the appellants with this order. If an Appellate Mediation Agreement form is not filed, an order will be issued regarding further proceedings.
