NOTICE AND ORDER OF HEARING ON PENDING MOTIONS

This notice and order schedules a hearing on pending motions for rehearing.

I. Background

On October 2, 2015, Antrim Wind Energy, LLC (Antrim Wind), filed an Application for a Certificate of Site and Facility (Application) with the Site Evaluation Committee (Committee). Antrim Wind proposed to site, construct, and operate 9 Siemens SWT-3.2-113 direct drive wind turbines each capable of generating 3.2 MW for a total nameplate capacity of 28.8 MW and associated civil and electrical infrastructure (Project.) The Project is proposed to be located in the Town of Antrim on the Tuttle Hill ridgeline spanning southwestward to the northeastern slope of Willard Mountain (Site). The Project will be constructed primarily on the ridgeline that starts approximately 0.75 miles south of NH Route 9 and runs south-west, for approximately 2 miles.

The adjudicative hearing took place over thirteen days during the months of September, October and November 2016. Deliberations took place on December 7, 9, and 12, 2016. On March 17, 2017, the Subcommittee issued a Decision and Order Granting the Application for Certificate of Site and Facility and an Order and Certificate of Site and Facility with Conditions (Certificate).

On March 25, 2017, the intervenor group known as the Meteorological Intervenors filed a Motion for Rehearing. On April 14, 2017, the Abutting Landowners Group, Non-Abutting Landowners Group, the Levesque-Allen Group, the Stoddard Conservation Commission, and the Windaction Group filed a Joint Motion for Rehearing. On April 17, 2017, Counsel for the Public filed a Motion for Rehearing.


II. Hearing on Motions

During the hearing, the Subcommittee will deliberate on the pending motions.
