

To Whom it May Concern:

As General Partner of Antrim Limited Partnership (“ALP”), comprising approximately 900 acres of land in Antrim, New Hampshire (the “Property”) and on behalf of all partners of ALP, I retain all rights and privileges to the development of said land with the exception of any concessions granted to Walden Green Energy (Antrim Wind Energy LLC). ALP has been in negotiations with Antrim Wind Energy LLC for more than six (6) years and has invested significant time and expense in legal fees in the development of this project.

At no point has any representative of Antrim Limited Partnership considered placing conservation restrictions on the Property other than those that ALP has agreed to with Antrim Wind Energy as a concession for the construction of the wind farm. As stated in the letter of intent with Antrim Wind, that conservation easement will not take effect unless and until four wind turbines are constructed on the Property.

Furthermore, no representative of ALP has ever been approached by any conservation entity seeking conservation restrictions on the Property. If approached, ALP would not consider any such restrictions.

Antrim Limited Partnership will consider any and all development opportunities relating to the Property regardless of the final outcome of the Antrim Wind Energy LLC.
