REVISED PROCEDURAL ORDER


Unless further amended, the following revised procedural schedule applies in this docket.

The entries in italics represent changes to the procedural schedule.

- Counsel for the Public and the Intervenors shall respond to Technical Session Data Requests on or before **May 31, 2018**;
- Patricia O'Donnell shall respond to Technical Session Data Requests on or before **June 4, 2018**;
- *The Applicant shall propound data requests upon Regis Miller, Jeffrey and Vivian Miller, and Matthew and Amanda Fitch (Durham Residents) related to their late-filed testimony on or before **June 18, 2018**;*
- *The Durham Residents shall respond to the Applicant's data requests on or before **June 25, 2018**;*
- The Applicant *and Counsel for the Public* shall file Supplemental Testimony and Information Pertaining to Additional Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) Studies on or before **July 1, 2018**;
- *Technical sessions concerning the Supplemental Testimony and Information Pertaining to HDD Studies and the Durham Residents shall be conducted on **July 10, 2018**, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Concord;*
- *The Durham Residents shall respond to Technical Session Data Requests related to their late-filed testimony no later than **July 16, 2018**;*
- The Intervenors shall file Supplemental Pre-Filed Testimony on or before **July 20, 2018**;
- Counsel for the Public shall file Supplemental Pre-Filed Testimony, *excluding Supplemental Testimony Pertaining to HDD*, on or before **July 20, 2018**;

- The Applicant shall file its Supplemental Rebuttal Testimony on or before **July 27, 2018**;
- The Parties shall file statements of stipulated facts and any other stipulations on or before **August 15, 2018**;
- The final pre-hearing conference shall be conducted on **August 22, 2018**, beginning at 9:00 a.m., at the Public Utilities Commission, 21 South Fruit Street, Concord.;
- The final adjudicative hearings shall take place *on the dates specified in the Notice issued on May 1, 2018*;
- Counsel for the Public and Intervenors shall file Final Briefs within **14 days** of the close of the record;
- The Applicant shall file its Final Brief within **21 days** of the close of the record;
- Deliberations will be scheduled thereafter subject to availability of the Subcommittee and a notice scheduling the deliberations will be issued; and
- A final written decision shall be issued within **60 days** of the conclusion of deliberations.
