NOTICE OF SCHEDULE OF PUBLIC STATEMENT HEARING



On **October 11, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.**, the Subcommittee will take oral statements from members of the public on the proposed project. The hearing will begin and end promptly at the stated times. Each speaker will be asked to limit their statements to 3 minutes.

The final roster and schedule of speakers is attached. The times listed are approximate-registered commenters are asked to be available prior to their scheduled time. If there is time remaining, members of the public who did not pre-register will be allowed to provide statements in the order that they sign-in. Individuals who do not wish to speak in public may have their statement read by a person of their choice.

The hearing will be held at the NH Dept. of Environmental Services, Pease Field Office, Pease Tradeport, 222 International Drive, #175, Portsmouth, NH. The directions to the facility are attached.

1. Take Route 4 East to Route 16 South (Spaulding Turnpike)
2. Take Exit 1 (Gosling Rd./ Pease Int'l Tradeport)
3. Turn right off exit onto Pease Blvd.
4. Turn left at first traffic light onto International Drive
5. After stopping at the four-way intersection, continue on International Drive for one mile. See 222 International, which is the large white building on the right.
6. Enter the driveway and drive around to the left to find the DES office in Suite 175.

From Maine:

1. Take 95 South to Exit 5 (US Route 4/NH Route 16)
2. Merge onto Route 16 North (Spaulding Turnpike)
3. Take Exit 1 (Gosling Rd./Pease Int'l Tradeport)
4. Turn left off exit onto Gosling Rd., which becomes Pease Blvd.
5. Turn left at second traffic light onto International Drive
6. After stopping at the four-way intersection, continue on International Drive for one mile. See 222 International, which is the large white building on the right.
7. Enter the driveway and drive around to the left to find the DES office in Suite 175.

From Massachusetts:

1. Take 95 North to Exit 4 (US Route 4/NH Route 16 – NH Lakes/White Mtns)

4. Turn left off exit onto Gosling Rd., which becomes Pease Blvd.
