Dear Ridge,

This letter provides you with identification of a new laydown area in the Town of Newington to be used for the construction of the Seacoast Reliability Project. This submittal is to comply with Condition 7 in the recommended Alteration of Terrain permit, dated October 29, 2018 adopted by the NH Site Evaluation Committee.

- *7. The Applicant shall identify to NHDES all marshaling yards, laydown areas and off-right-of-way access ways not currently identified for review prior to their construction.*

The new laydown area is located at the former Toys R' Us parking lot, shown on Figure 1. The lay down consists of a paved area between the Crossings Mall and Gosling Road in Newington. The space to be utilized is approximately 2.5 acres of paved area, and contains no wetlands or cultural resources. No additional clearing or site improvement is proposed. This area is shown in Exhibit A.

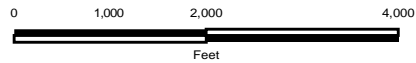
