On Saturday December 7, 2019, New River Electric was performing a final step in the termination of the three submarine cables at riser structure #99 on the former Getchel property (295 Durham Point Rd). This process requires the heating of oil for several hours before it can be poured. Once this operation commences it cannot be stopped before completion without great risk to the quality of the termination. This operation went slightly longer than expected and lasted until approximately 6:45 PM. All contractors were off site by 7:00 PM.

Eversource and its contractors held a meeting first thing this morning to discuss the work hour requirements and methods to prevent any exceedance of work hours from happening again. The Town of Durham has been notified of this as well.
