I would like to go on record that for environmental reasons I am opposed to Eversource's Seacoast Reliability Project's plan to jetplow across Little Bay. Too little is known about the negative impact such plowing will have on the Great Bay estuary, one of the treasures of northern New England. As a waterfront homeowner, I accept the many restrictions as to what we can and cannot do on the shoreline. The fact that Eversource plans to use huge machinery to churn up the sediment in Little Bay, possibly releasing buried toxins and metals from previous industrial sites along the shoreline is, quite frankly, scary! And this at a time when we are seeing a return of oyster beds in the estuary and bald eagles nesting within a few hundred yards of the proposed plow site.
