JOINT APPLICATION OF NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY D/B/A NATIONAL GRID & PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE D/B/A EVERSOURCE ENERGY FOR A CERTIFICATE OF SITE AND FACILITY

APPLICANTS' UNCONTESTED MOTION TO HAVE TECHINICAL SESSION TRANSCRIBED

NOW COME New England Power Company d/b/a National Grid ("NEP") and Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy ("PSNH") (collectively the "Applicants") by and through their attorneys, McLane Middleton, Professional Association, and respectfully move to have the technical session of Intervenor Huard transcribed and to have a transcript of the technical session prepared by a licensed stenographer.

- 1. On May 5, 2016, the parties will hold a technical session for Intervenor Huard at the Public Utilities Commission.
- 2. The Applicants respectfully move to have the technical session transcribed and to have a transcript prepared of the session.
- 3. The Applicants will assume the burden of locating and hiring a licensed stenographer and the burden of paying for the costs associated with such services, including, the costs of preparing a transcript and a copy for the Committee. The intervening parties would be able to obtain a copy directly from the stenographer at their own expense.
- 4. Intervenor Huard previously made a similar request. The Applicants did not object but asked that Intervenor Huard assume the responsibility of paying for the costs associated with the transcription and reproduction of transcripts.

- 5. The Committee granted Intervenor Huard's request to record and transcribe the technical sessions. See Order Granting In Part and Denying IN Part Motion to Record Technical Sessions and Have Transcript Prepared, Docket 2015-05 (Feb. 25, 2016) (stating that "[t]he request to record and transcribe technical sessions is a reasonable request"). Intervenor Huard, however, was required to arrange for and pay the costs associated with recording and the preparation of transcripts.
- 6. Intervenor Huard does not object to this Motion. Counsel for the Public assents to this Motion.

WHEREFORE, the Applicants respectfully request that the Committee:

- A. Grant their request to have Intervenor Huard's technical session transcribed; and
- B. Grant such further relief as requested herein and as deemed appropriate.
