On behalf of McKenna's Purchase Unit Owners Association we hereby petition the State of New Hampshire's Site Evaluation Committee to grant us full intervention status in the proceedings for the above mentioned docket due to the existing right of way (ROW) located on the Association's property.

We request the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee grant us intervention status for the entire Association Membership (membership list available upon request) consisting of 148 individually owned townhomes that would ALL be negatively affected by this project for the following reasons:

- Property Values / Loss of Concord Tax Revenue
- Loss of Health & Safety (EMF's)
- Destruction / disturbance of the Association's land and property
- Way of Life
- View Sheds
- Noise
- Overburdening of an already overburdened ROW
- High Voltage Transmission lines near a natural gas line
- Fall radius

The Association was granted intervening status with the U.S. Department of Energy pertaining to this proposed project and as such we request the same with the State of New Hampshire.

We strongly feel that no other individual, agency or organization could articulate or represent our specific interests and concerns in the proceedings as well as we can.

For these reasons, we ask that the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee grant us full intervention status as requested.
