We respectfully respond and object to the Petition submitted by Northern Pass as it seeks to have the Site Evaluation Committee deny E. Martin Kaufman, MD, Janice Kaufman, Herman Lerner, MD, Arthur Weinstein permission to intervene or otherwise limit our intervention.

Northern Pass has listed our petition as Non-Abutting Property owners Not Within One Hundred Feet of the Project.

Their characterization of our deeded properties is incorrect. Mr. Weinstein's property is directly across the Heath Road from the proposed Transition Station according to Jim Wagner representing Northern Pass during a recent visit to clarify the location of the Northern Pass Project in relation to our easement and property. Mr. Weinstein's property is well within 100 feet of the project. In addition, the easement traverses the 120 foot corridor of the proposed HVDC line which is of major concern to us. We have chosen to petition collectively, rather than individually, because the easement provides water to each of our homes. The proximity of the Northern Pass Project to our land is being incorrectly characterized. We ask, in the interest of accuracy and to the spirit of this process, that the SEC approve our petition to intervene.
