I am respectfully requesting that as Coos County Commissioner for District Three and a recognized intervener that I am allowed to represent and be the spokesperson for my District independent of the Grafton County commissioners.

The distance, geography, and economic condition of the two counties are very different and our concerns and issues are also vastly different. I represent eleven towns and four unincorporated places.

The six towns of Pittsburg, Clarksville, Stewartstown, Dummer, Stark and Groveton or Northumberland as well as the two unincorporated places of Dixville and Millsfield will be directly affected by the proposed project.

RSA 162-H:16 IV (b) and (c) require the committee to consider the views of municipal governing bodies on the projects impact on the orderly growth of the region and the economic impact as well.

I would also at this time respectfully request that another site visit be scheduled in District Three with advanced notice and the visits be scheduled where there will be a definite direct impact on the view shed of this proposed project.
