RE: Technical Session Data Requests

A technical session was held on October 14, 2016, in the above referenced docket. The purpose of the technical sessions is for the parties to inquire of the Applicant's witnesses their expertise, opinions and pre-filed testimony. The parties that were present during all or part of the technical sessions on each day are listed on the sign-in sheets that are attached to this memorandum. Peter Roth, Counsel for the Public, and his attorney, Eli Emerson were both present.

At the conclusion of the technical sessions, the following data requests to the Applicant remain outstanding:

Oct. 14-Historical Resources-Cherilyn Widell

- 1. Provide the list of historic resources, cultural landscapes, agricultural districts, and potential historic districts, that are greater than 1 mile beyond the APE, and that Ms. Widell evaluated.
- 2. Provide a list of the specific areas of potential effect where Ms. Widell consulted with Northern Pass, and the project design changes that were made as a result of this consultation, if any. Include the specific recommendations that were made and whether they were accepted or rejected.
- 3. Provide any notes or calculations that exist from Ms. Widell's site visit(s) to the Boston, Concord, Montreal Railroad Bridge located in Ashland.
- 4. Review whether or not Old Dalton Place, Whittemore Point Cemetery, Webster Toll Bridge and House, and Dick Brown Mill are within the APE, and if so, provide an explanation as to why these resources were not assessed (Page 1 of 12 of the Bridgewater Town Summary).

- 5. Provide any notes that Preservation Company has from its site visit to 1868 River Road (Webster Tavern and Farm, BRID 04) and its assessment of the view of the Project.
- 6. Provide any notes that Preservation Company has from its site visit to 3252 River Road (BRID 16), and its assessment of the view of the Project.
- 7. Provide information as to whether or not there are "night lights," on any of the Project's poles.
- 8. Provide the calculation that was conducted, if any, that was used to support the statement that most of the historic properties to the west of the Project within the APE, in Bridgewater, along the Pemigewasset River face south or west. (Page 3 of 12 in the Bridgewater Town Summary).

The foregoing shall be provided to all of the parties on or before October 31, 2016. Copies shall <u>not</u> be provided to the Committee. To the extent that the Applicant objects to providing the above referenced material, the requesting party must file a Motion to Compel with the Committee. Any questions regarding this memorandum or the data requests made at the technical session should be directed to Pamela Monroe, Administrator.
